Louisiana Ethics Reporting

Per guidance from the Louisiana Board of Ethics and the Acceptance of Electronic Signatures Policy (LA R.S. 9:2601(5)), Form 413 may be signed electronically only if the electronic signature is applied using approved software that meets specific validation criteria.

Accepted Electronic Signatures

Electronic signatures must be generated through software that displays one or more of the following on or near the signature:

- Signer's identity
- Date and/or time of signing
- Confirmation number
- Electronic signature provider's watermark or branding near the signature or on the signed page

Unaccepted Electronic Signatures

The following are not considered valid and will result in rejection of the disclosure:

- Textbox/typed font signatures
- Adobe Fill & Sign signatures without the separate complimentary disclosure page displaying the date/time stamp or confirmation information
