To the members of Sigma Chi Fraternity,

Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Sigma Chi Fraternity, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

#### 10.2 Alcohol – Responsible

As a result of the incident that occurred on April 15, 2022, where Sigma Chi Fraternity held their annual Formal off-campus and served prohibited alcohol, which is prohibited per PS-78, Sigma Chi has submitted an Enhancement Plan. This will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Student Advocacy & Accountability:

#### Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective August 9, 2022 through May 31, 2023. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning will be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

1. Sigma Chi will develop a Contract Review Committee which will be chaired by the Consul and Chapter Advisor. This committee will review all contracts signed for the chapter. Sigma Chi will submit a copy of the appropriate by-law revisions to SAA by August 31, 2022.
2. The Gamma Iota chapter is expected to review all Sigma Chi Internal Fraternity and LSU policies and procedures regarding drugs and alcohol, social event planning, and risk management. All policies must be reviewed and verbalized to the chapter by the Consul at the first chapter meeting of the Fall 2022 semester. The Chapter Advisor or Grand Praetor are required to attend this meeting. The chapter will provide proof of at least 80% attendance including new members to SAA by August 31, 2022.
3. Sigma Chi will collaborate with Greek Life staff to facilitate a Chapter Wide Improvement Meeting at a regularly scheduled chapter meeting by September 15, 2022. The chapter will have 80% attendance and

submit proof of attendance and agenda to SAA by September 15, 2022.

4. Sigma Chi will complete their Values Based Decision Making education program as required by the International Organization. This presentation will be delivered virtually, but the chapter will attend the training at a central physical location to ensure members are engaged in the presentation. The chapter will have at least an 80% attendance including new members and submit proof of attendance to SAA by August 31, 2022.

5. Sigma Chi will complete their Drinking Smart education program as required by the International Organization. This presentation will be delivered virtually, but the chapter will attend the training at a central physical location to ensure members are engaged in the presentation. The chapter will have at least an 80% attendance including new members and submit proof of attendance to SAA by August 31, 2022.

6. Sigma Chi Consul and Risk Manager will collaborate with Student Advocacy and Accountability to develop and present a sober monitor training for the Chapter. The chapter will have at least an 80% attendance including new members and submit proof of attendance to SAA by August 31, 2022.

7. The chapter has self-imposed the following social restrictions for the Fall 2022 semester.

a. The chapter will not host any social event prior to September 1, 2022.

b. The chapter will not host a semi-formal or formal social event during the Fall 2022 semester.

8. Sigma Chi must complete the Values Based Decision Making, Drinking Smart, and Sober Monitoring educational programs before they are permitted to host any social events.

9. Sigma Chi must complete any additional outcomes assigned by the International Organization.

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
