Key Themes That Emerged:

Theme 1: Mental & Personal Challenges

 Students may struggle with mental health, family responsibilities, or balancing time, affecting attendance.

Theme 2: Attendance Policy & Grading

• Faculty emphasize that **clear attendance policies** and **tying attendance to grades** could influence behavior.

Theme 3: Student Engagement & Choice A lack of motivation or perception that attendance isn't necessary may drive absenteeism.

Theme 4: External Barriers

•Issues like job commitments, disengagement, COVIDera habits, and even parking challenges are cited.

Theme 5: Course Design & Motivation

•The structure and appeal of the course itself play a role—students skip when they feel not engagement with classes through homework, pop-quizzes, etc.

Faculty Suggestions For Improving Attendance

Top 9 Suggestions

1. Make attendance mandatory and tie it to grades or participation points.

2. Assign participation grades to increase accountability.

3. Stop recording lectures to encourage inperson attendance.

4. Create a university-wide attendance policy for consistency.

5. Tie scholarships (like TOPS) to attendance requirements.

6. Provide faculty with **more authority** to enforce attendance rules.

7. Emphasize the **value of in-class learning** and structure classes accordingly.

8. Reframing student identity away from a **"consumer mindset."**

9. Encouraging better **academic preparedness** before enrollment.
